National HealthCare Group milestones

Herewith a brief recap of some of the growth milestones achieved by the Group in recent years:

- The National HealthCare Group was established in 2017, with investment from Patrice Motsepe's African Rainbow Capital, in order to bring affordable and reliable private primary healthcare services to low-income employer groups through specially designed products such as MediClub Premier and Elite.
- Soon afterwards, we established and branded NIPA, our own independent practitioner association comprising of 1 300 doctors.
- With the acquisition of Enablemed in June 2019, National HealthCare Group added an additional 12 500 beneficiaries under its management, while more than doubling its independent provider network to 2 900.
- With the on-boarding of Essential Employee Benefits (EEB) in October 2019, a further 6 000 beneficiaries were added to the National HealthCare fold.
- By February 2020 these beneficiaries doubled with the addition of a further 6 000 beneficiaries from EEB.



Some important milestones achieved in recent months include the following:

- At the beginning of May 2020, National HealthCare's low-cost, WhatsApp-based primary healthcare service, MediClub Connect[™], went live. This highly affordable product, which is marketed at R95 per employee per month, has been particularly well received by South African companies.
- One of the first companies to introduce this vital new benefit, which provides access to professional advice, referrals to general practitioners, medication and other key services to its employees, was fast-food chain, Hungry Lion. The chain introduced MediClub Connect[™] to 2 900 employees within the workplace at the height of the COVID-19 pandemic.
- We swiftly took over the risk transfer arrangement of the Sizwe Copper Core members in the Eastern Cape.
- We recently enhanced the MediClub Connect[™] Premier and Elite benefits to existing corporate customers. The employee assist programme now available on these options includes a 24/7 personal health advisor, debt and credit assist, legal assistance and trauma counselling.
- One of our most significant milestones achieved is the fact that the National HealthCare Group now, through Enablemed, lays claim to a proud 25-year heritage. The silver seal that was introduced into our corporate communications as from 1 June marks this fine achievement, which we believe sets us apart.
